

Police investigating homicide in King

Investigators with the York Regional Police Homicide Unit are seeking witnesses connected to a homicide investigation in the Township of King. On Friday, June 17 at approximately 5:45 p.m., York Regional Police responded to a residence on John Street, in the area of King Road west of Keele Street, for a report of an injured person. When officers arrived on scene, they located a male victim who was unresponsive suffering from a stab wound. The victim was transported to hospital where he succumbed to his injuries. The victim has been identified as Noran Leslie-Durrant, 24, of Toronto. The Homicide Unit has taken over the investigation. This is believed to be a targeted incident and investigators do not believe there is a concern for public safety. Officers have arrested and charged one person with Accessory After the Fact. Charged is 57-year-old Kimberly Graham of King. Investigators are appealing to anyone with information to please come forward, including anyone with video surveillance or dashcam footage in the area.
