

Murder charges laid

Investigators with the York Regional Police Homicide Unit have arrested and charged two people with First Degree Murder in connection with the death of an 18-year-old man in the Township of King. On Sunday, April 23, at 7:50 a.m., York Regional Police received a call from a citizen who reported finding a deceased person while walking their dog along a trail northwest of a college campus in the area of Dufferin Street and 15 th Sideroad. The death was deemed suspicious and members of the Homicide Unit took carriage of the investigation. A post-mortem examination took place on April 24 and the victim was identified as Zackhry Ramnath, 18, of Montreal, Quebec. Through the investigation, officers identified the two suspects. A 15-year old female was arrested on June 5, and a 19-year-old man was arrested on July 5. Lyjah Griffiths, 19, of Cambridge, and the 15-year-old were both charged with first degree murder.
