Results delivered for King residents

As 2019 draws to a close and we take stock of our accomplishments, I'm proud to say we were able to deliver results for King Township's ratepayers this year.

We're just completing our first full year in the new Municipal Centre at 2585 King Rd. The building, which was built to replace the previous aging strip plaza, has served not only staff but also the community beyond our expectations.

Our new ServiceKing citizen service model has worked extremely well. Front counter staff is able to take care of the vast majority of customer needs, from paying for extra garbage stickers to registering for Parks, Recreation and Culture programs.

The multi-use gymnasium has been a hit with the community. From seniors playing pickleball on Fridays to the youngsters exploring indoor play equipment on Thursday mornings to community groups using it on evenings for various events, the building truly feels like a community hub.

One of the biggest accomplishments for us this year was the approval of our new Official Plan, Our King. The final document was several years in the making. It's an extremely important plan as it sets out guidelines for all aspects of planning in King Township to the year 2031. It was drafted with a massive amount of community feedback, both in person at numerous open houses and public meetings, as well as through our online engagement platform Speaking (www.speaking.king.ca).

One of the most visible accomplishments we made in 2019 was an ambitious road improvement and safety program.

Under the direction of council, staff built a program that focused on three different issues: road improvement; traffic calming, and streetscaping.

Roads are, without question, the number one issue our residents have told us they want us to focus on. Residents want roads that are in good repair and are safe. We're delivering solutions to these issues.

Staff has identified several gravel roads that will be paved as well as hard surfaced roads that will be repaved.

We also have to address driver behaviours in our neighbourhoods. That's why we've also launched the Traffic Calming Pilot Project. Two areas were chosen for traffic calming measures this year - Parkheights Trail in Nobleton and Church Street and Western Avenue in Schomberg.

A mix of measures were used, including signage, speed tables



and flexible bollards. King is also asking residents to share their opinions on traffic calming measures through Speaking. On the site residents can learn more about traffic calming, take a survey and play the engineer by placing virtual pins on a map to show where they would like traffic calming measures placed.

The third project currently under way is streetscaping on King Road in King City. The plan is to improve the stretch from the Municipal Centre to Dufferin Street. Improvements will include sidewalk replacements, a multi-use path, tree planting, banner and poles, street furniture and limited lighting. Construction is currently underway. It's scheduled to be completed by late 2020.

These are just a few of the large, visible accomplishments we made in 2019. Council and staff work behind the scenes every day to make King such a great place to live, work and play.

In closing and on behalf of King council and staff I wish you and your loved ones a safe and peaceful holiday season.

TRAFFIC CALMING PROJECT

- Traffic calming is creating a safer roadside environment by reducing speeds and encouraging responsible driver behavior.

Legislature Adjourns after Productive and Collaborative Session

After a successful fall session, the Ontario Legislature will be adjourning until the new year. Since October, the Government of Ontario has worked collaboratively with Members of all parties to more effectively and efficiently deliver on its plan for the people of Ontario.

“This has been an incredibly productive legislative session,” said Minister Paul Calandra, the Government House Leader. “We have worked across the aisle on initiatives such as the Fall Economic Statement, the Provincial Animal Welfare Services Act, the Trust in Real Estate Services Act, the modernization of the rules and procedures of the Legislature, and the Poet Laureate of Ontario Act, sponsored by Percy Hatfield, MPP for Windsor-Tecumseh.”

Over the past several weeks, the Ontario Government has many Legislative accomplishments, including:

- Passed Bill 116, the Foundations for Promoting and Protecting Mental Health and Addictions Services Act which, if assented to by the Lieutenant Governor, will establish a Mental Health and Addictions Centre of Excellence within Ontario Health and support the province’s participation in a national class action lawsuit against more than 40 opioid manufacturers and wholesalers.
- Passed Bill 132, the Better for People, Smarter for Business Act which will simplify and modernize regulations while protecting health and safety.
- Passed Bill 136, the Provincial Animal Welfare Services Act, which implements the strongest penalties in Canada for people who violate animal welfare laws while enhancing oversight and accountability.
- Passed Bill 138, the Fall Economic Statement, A Plan to Build Ontario Together Act, which delivered on the government’s commitment to cut Ontario’s small business tax rate by 8.7 per cent and helped reduce the cost of living in northern Ontario by cutting the aviation fuel tax.
- Passed Bill 124, the Protecting a Sustainable Public Sector for Future Generations Act.
- Introduced the Trust in Real Estate Services Act which has now passed second reading. This bill if passed, would increase consumer confidence, enhance standards for real estate professionals and brokerages and provide additional flexibility to keep pace with a modern marketplace.

and their farm animals by addressing unique risks associated with on-farm trespass.

- Introduced the Rebuilding Consumer Confidence Act, which, if passed would overhaul the Ontario new home warranties and protection program, reforming Tarion Warranty Corporation, making it consumer-focused.
- Introduced the Smarter and Stronger Justice Act which, if passed will modernize and improve how legal aid services are delivered, class actions are handled, and how court processes are administered. This bill also paves the way to allow identities and legal documents to be verified online, making life easier for the people of Ontario.
- Successfully modernized the rules of the Legislative Assembly of Ontario to enhance debate, empower independent Members, and allow the accommodation and full participation of Members of Provincial Parliament with disabilities.
- Worked across party lines to advance two Private Members’ Bills - Bill 6, the Poet Laureate of Ontario Act, sponsored by NDP MPP Percy Hatfield and Bill 123, co-sponsored by PC MPP Lorne Coe and Green Party Leader Mike Schreiner, which would create a fine for drivers who block parking spaces that are reserved for electric vehicle charging.

“Our priorities this legislative session have been to restore trust and accountability in government, to reduce red tape and regulatory burdens for our job creators, and to build safer communities,” added Minister Calandra. “While there is still much work to be done, I am very pleased with the progress that we have made and the cross-partisan relationships we continue to build.”

EDUCATION WITH BALANCE

Province's first assessment will help identify climate change risks

Ontario is taking another step forward in its fight to address climate change by undertaking the first-ever multi-sector provincial climate impact assessment.

The assessment will help the province better understand where and how it is vulnerable to the effects of climate change, and will provide information to communities to help them undertake a more strategic approach to adaptation planning and infrastructure investments to prevent and mitigate climate change risks.

"Our government is taking action in the global fight to reduce emissions and strengthen our resilience to the impacts of climate change that are already happening in our communities, such as more frequent extreme weather events and flooding," said Jeff Yurek, Minister of the Environment, Conservation and Parks. "This impact assessment will help the province, municipalities, Indigenous communities and other local partners make more informed and timely decisions to keep communities and people healthy and safe."

Ontario will access the best science and information to determine where and how climate change is likely to affect communities, critical infrastructure, economies and the natural environment. As a first step, the government has posted a request for bids to procure a vendor with expertise in the

assessment of impacts, vulnerabilities, risks and opportunities across a wide range of sectors.

Launching Ontario's first-ever climate change impact assessment is a key part of the government's Made-in-Ontario Environment Plan to protect our air, land and water, prevent and reduce litter, and support communities and families to continue to do their share to reduce greenhouse gas emission and increase their resilience to climate change without a carbon tax.

Under a business-as-usual global emissions scenario, Ontario's average annual temperatures are projected to rise by more than 3°C by the 2050s.

The severe ice storm in April 2018 resulted in \$190 million of insured property damage in Ontario. Less than a month later, a wind storm caused \$380 million in insured damages.

Ontario has issued a request for bids to procure a vendor for the climate change impact assessment. The contract will be awarded in early 2020 and the assessment will take place over two years. The release of the final impact assessment is slated for 2022.

In addition to implementing the climate change impact assessment to help Ontarians prepare for the impacts of climate change, the government is also working to address climate change by reducing greenhouse gas emissions from large emitters through its finalized emissions performance standards.

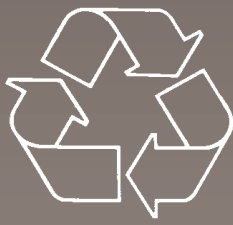

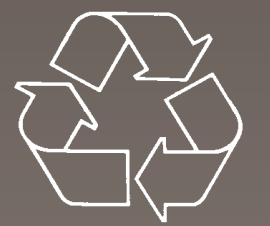

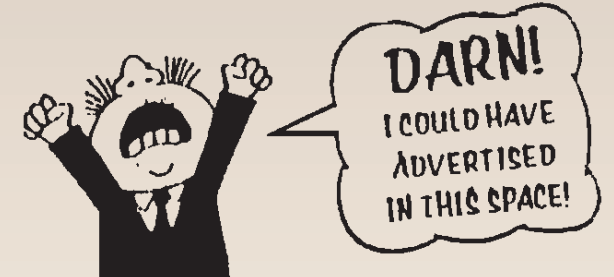
